




English:

We will be continuing with our Read Write Inc phonics programme at individual levels.



In reading, we will continue to develop the skill of reading for understanding, to read expressively, to make predictions about what might happen in the story and to look at the features of information texts.

Within classes we will be looking at stories focussing on characters and settings, information texts and poetry. The children will write in sentences using finger spaces between each word, a capital letter to begin each sentence and a full stop at the end. We will look at improving our writing by including more detail and writing at greater length.

Maths:

In maths we will be:



- continuing to work on our addition and subtraction skills. We will continue to practise writing our addition and subtraction expressions using the + - and = symbols.
- using positional language and learning our left and right.
- making whole and half turns.
- understanding the composition of number from 0-100.
- Counting in steps of 2, 5 and 10.

Creative Curriculum:

Our Topic is "Dinosaur Planet".

We will be continuing our learning about dinosaurs and we will be imagining that we are palaeontologists (a scientist who studies bones and fossils). We are going to dig deep and discover dazzling dinosaur facts. We will be doing dinosaur dances and producing some prehistoric percussion! Which is your favourite dinosaur?

History

We will be learning about dinosaurs, learning about events beyond living memory and we will be investigating what happened to the dinosaurs.

Art/DT

We will be working as a team to create models of dinosaurs using junk materials. We will also be making our own fossils using dough.

Music

We will be creating sound effects using the voice, body percussion, everyday objects and percussion instruments.

RE and PSHE

In R.E, we will be exploring the Sikhism faith and symbolism.

In PSHE, the children will be thinking about belonging to a community and keeping healthy.

British Values:

We will be looking at individual liberty and celebrating our uniqueness and individual strengths. We will also think about our feelings and the feelings of others.

Computing:

We will become digital designers and use a range of computer software and apps to create our own art work.



PE:

In gymnastics, we will be identifying and using basic gymnastic shapes and actions. In dance, we will build simple movement patterns incorporating our dinosaur topic.
