

Reception Summer Term 2021




<u>Literacy</u>

We will continue to work in our RWI groups to learn new sounds to help us to read and write words. We will also begin to develop our understanding of what we read.

<u>Talk for Writing</u>

Our book for this half term is 'The Hungry Caterpillar' by Eric Carle. We will be making story maps to help recall events in the story. We will also make changes to the story to invent a new story.



<u>Our topic for the half term</u>

Why do ladybirds have spots?

Through this topic we will be looking at different mini beasts in the local environment, naming them and exploring similarities and differences. We will also be looking at the different parts of flowers.

<u>Expressive Art and Design</u>

We will be painting pictures of different mini beasts using appropriate colours and making pebble beetles.

Communication, Language and Literacy We will be working on listening attentively for longer periods of time, following instructions of more than one step and answering questions appropriately.

We will focus on composition of numbers 9 and 10 including corresponding subtraction facts. We will also be looking at 3D shapes, pattern, weight, and the days of the week.

<u>Physical Development</u> (Every Wednesday)

During this half term, we will be doing gymnastics. We will be making up our own sequences and using the apparatus to climb through, on, under and across.
