<u>Literacy</u>

We will continue to work in our RWI groups to learn new sounds to help us to read and write words.

<u>Talk for Writing</u>

Our book for this half term is a non-fiction book called 'We Travel So Far' by Laura Knowles and Chris Madden. We will be reading the book, talking about the journeys the different animals make and finding out about the countries the animals live in. We will be writing lists, fact sheets and writing stories about the animals.

Maths


We will continue to look at addition and subtraction. We will look at different strategies to work out answers and solve simple word problems.

We will be estimating, doubling and halving numbers. We will also look at days of the week, ordinal numbers and 3D shapes and their properties.

Physical Development (every Thursday) During this half term we will be looking at different outdoor games and practising

skills for our Sports Day.

Our topic for the half term will be: Journeys.



During the topic we will be learning about where we live and what it would be like to live in a hot or cold country. We will also be thinking about journeys to the seaside.

<u>Expressive Art and Design</u>

We will be making pictures and collages, maps and models of different animals from our class book and different types of transport.

<u>Communication, Language and Literacy</u> We will be working on answering in sentences. We will continue to listen to class stories and share ideas.

<u>Understanding the World</u>

We will be finding out about different countries, what it would be like to live there and how to get to the countries. We will be making and looking at maps.

We will be learning about different Bible stories.

We will be programming code-a-pilars, and the bee-bots to move in different directions. We will also use the iPads and laptops to access age appropriate software.
