During this half term, the childr will

be encouraged to listen for the initial sounds in words. We will be attempting to hear and write some sounds in words. We will be encouraging the children to write their names and other words independently.

Communication and Language

The children will be continuing to learn about rhyme and alliteration. We will be playing games to hear the initial sounds in words. The children will be practising recognising letters and blending the sounds in words.
