Mobile Phones in school

Dear Parents/Carers,

We have a number of children bringing mobile phones into school. Unless there is a specific reason why your child needs to bring their phones to school, we would ask that they leave them at home.

If your child brings their mobile phone into school we ask that they are:

- switched off once they come through the gates at Sandwell Road or Rakegate Close
- handed into the main office as soon as they arrive
- collected from the main office at 3.10pm, once they have been dismissed from the key stage 2 gate
- not switched back on until they have exited the gates at Sandwell Road or Rakegate Close

Whilst Mrs Harris and Mrs Cook are willing to store the phones in the office during the day, they are not responsible for any damage or loss to these items.

If children are seen to be using their mobile phones on premises, I will confiscate them and parents will need to collect.
