Homework Arrangements

Nursery

Years 3 & 4

Projects	1 per ½ term

Years 5 & 6

Homework set	Frequency
Reading	Daily (at least 3 signatures per week in diaries)
Spellings (6 words per week)	Weekly
Literacy	Weekly
Maths	Weekly
Projects	1 per term

Year 6 will receive SATs revision packs from the Spring term.

All weekly homework from Years 1-6, is due back the following <u>MONDAY</u>. Reading records are checked daily. Spelling tests for Years 1-6 will take place on a <u>MONDAY</u>. Homework will be given out by <u>Wednesday</u> allowing sufficient time to be completed.

Children in Years 3-6 have the opportunity to attend a homework club on Thursday lunchtimes where they can receive help and support from teachers. Children who are in additional groups for maths or English may also receive other homework.

Teachers monitor what homework is returned and if a child fails to hand in their homework on time on 3 occasions over the term parents/carers will be informed and invited in to discuss this with a member of staff. Children will be rewarded at the end of a term for completing homework on time each week.

Bug Club is available for home use, children's log-on and password details are in their reading diaries.
