Star Ranking:	ENGLISH	MATHS	TOPIC/SCIENCE
	Read a story set during WWII and write a book review about it.	Research popular wartime recipes and bake or cook a chosen wartime recipe. (Remember to be careful when weighing and measuring out your ingredients).	Think about what you would pack if you were being evacuated during WWII. Create a presentation to show the items you might take and reasons why you would take them.
	Imagine you have been evacuated. Write a letter home to your parents.	Find out about quantities of food given out during rationing in WWII. Can you convert these quantities from imperial measures to metric measures to find out how much you would receive each week?	Make your own artefact from WWII. This could be a rationing book, an evacuation case, gas mask, soldier's helmet or a medal. Present your artefact including facts about it.
	Write an adventure story about a child during WWII.	Research old British currency and write some WWII maths money problems. Try to include all four number operations and multi-step problems.	Research the 'Make Do and Mend' initiative. Create a new toy using only recycled materials.
