Dear Parents/Carers,

Re: Year 5 Swimming Lessons

We have arranged to take Year 5 to Kings High School for swimming Lessons this academic year. As Kings pool can only cater for one class at a time (rather than the whole Year Group) **5JG** will swim for the first half of the year and **5PJ** for the second half of the year. These lessons are part of the National Curriculum to ensure that all children have the opportunity to learn swimming skills before they leave primary school. The lessons will take place **every Monday at 1.30pm. 5JG will start swimming from Monday 9th September.** A coach will transport the children to their lessons. There will be no charge for transport or the swimming lessons - this will be paid for from school funds. Qualified swimming coaches from Splash Schools Direct will run the swimming course. There will also be a minimum of two school staff accompanying the children to their swimming session.

SPECIAL DETAILS: Your child will need to bring an appropriate swimming costume – **a one piece costume for girls (no bikinis or tankinis please); trunks/shorts for boys (no long shorts please); a towel and a swimming hat (for those children with long hair).** This should be brought in a suitable bag. Children must not bring sprays/gels etc. If a child has a verruca they can still swim, but will need a verruca sock, which is a rubber close-fitting sock that you can buy in a chemist. Kings High School have advised that if a child has head lice then they cannot swim. Please check your child's head regularly and treat any outbreaks. If your child is unable to go swimming for medical or any other reasons please supply us with a short note of explanation.

We would be grateful if parents of pupils from both classes would return the form below to the relevant class teacher in order to allocate your child a place in the right swimming ability group. Failure to return the permission slip and notify us of your child's swimming ability will result in your child not being able to take part in swimming sessions.
