**	Write a non-chronological report about your favourite sea creature.	Find the average length of 5 different sharks. Can you present your findings in a bar chart?	Research a food chain that might occur in the Pacific Ocean. Describe the animals and plants in the food chain.
***	Write a persuasive letter to a supermarket, persuading them to stop using plastic carrier bags. Remember to include reasons and the impact of plastic on the environment.	Plan a round the world cruise. What distances will you travel? How much will it cost? How long will the journey take?	Create an under the sea scene in a shoe box.
