



English: We will be practising sound recognition and how sounds are written within RWI groups on 4 mornings each week. This will be followed by an English lesson where we will share a range of text types such as poetry, fiction and non-fiction. In Autumn 1, we will be looking at stories with repeated phrases and sharing books such as 'Peace at Last' and 'Can't you sleep Little Bear'. In Autumn 2, we will look at stories with familiar settings such as, 'Knuffle Bunny'. We will be learning to verbally construct and then write in sentences by using capital letters, finger spaces between each word and a full stop at the end of each sentence. The children will be encouraged to use their phonic knowledge to spell unknown words.



Maths: We will be learning to-

- count a set of objects reliably and recognise numbers
- order numbers
- continue familiar sequences
- add and subtract and use the language of addition and subtraction
- sort and make sets
- compare and measure length using uniform and non-standard units
- find 1 more or less than any number
- name 2D shapes and sort them
- recognise number bonds to 10
- recognise coins.



Creative Curriculum:

Our topics are:

Autumn 1 Home Sweet Home.
Autumn 2 Great Britain.

In geography, we will be looking at the main features of our local area, including the role of the canal, going on a neighbourhood walk and producing maps. We will also be looking at the city of Wolverhampton and begin to look at Great Britain and the countries it is made up of.

In Art and DT, we will be looking at the primary colours, collages, and studying the artist Paul Klee. In DT we will be designing and making houses for our class bear.

In music we will be learning to appraise pieces of music and making sound effects to accompany a poem or picture. We will also learn about high and low sounds.

In RE we will be learning about prayer and how Christians view Jesus. We will also be thinking about the puzzles in life and learning to ask big questions.

Computing:

In Computing we will be using the i-pads and the laptops to support our learning in other areas of the curriculum and research topics.



British Values:

As part of British Values, we will be looking at who we are and what it means to be British. We will be discussing our role in the community, respect for everyone and caring for each other.

Science:

In Autumn 1, we will be learning about our senses, name and label parts of our body and those of some animals. We will be learning about ourselves by using mirrors and writing poems using our senses.

In Autumn 2, we will be naming different materials and describing what they are like.

PE: Our PE will cover dance and games and we will be looking at throwing and catching and learning to follow instructions. In dance, we will be using space, using limbs in isolation, copying movements and varying speed and levels.
