Dear Parents/ Carers,

There will be a variety of stalls and we are asking for contributions for each one. To try to ensure we have a balance of items to sell, donations would be very much appreciated linked to items allocated to the year groups listed below:

Nursery/Reception: Fill a cup. Children will be given a paper cup to bring home to decorate and fill with anything of their choice.

Year 1: Chocolate item e.g. box of chocolates, selection box, bar of chocolate for a tombola

Year 2: Toiletries/smellies

Year 3: Toys

Year 4: Books

Year 5: Cakes - homemade or shop bought

Year 6: Bottles – a bottle of anything to sell
