This week in Reception...

we have been reading the story of 'Little Red Riding Hood'. In Literacy we thought about the sequence of the story and found out and wrote facts about wolves. In Maths we introduced the concept of addition and used Numicon to help us work out the answers. In Understanding of the World we found out about Wolves, looking at where they lived and what they ate. In the creative area we investigated suitable materials for making a new cape for Little Red Riding Hood.
