Choose <u>at least</u> one English task, one maths task and one creative task from the table below. The tasks are ranked accordingly, from 1 star being the easiest level to 3 stars being the hardest. You can choose which level you complete. If you wish to, you could complete <u>more than</u> three tasks.

Star Ranking:	ENGLISH	MATHS	CREATIVE
	Find definitions for: Banquet, Monasteries, Protestant, Reformation, Supremacy, Treason and Poor Law. Present the key words in an attractive glossary.	Using Tudor key words and information, create 5 word problems to show the four operations; addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Could some word problems show more than one operation?	Create a menu for either: a) A feast at the Royal Palace, or b) A day in a normal person's house. Cook, bake, draw, or use pictures to make a college of your meals on the menu.
	Write a poem or song which summarises an event in the Tudor period. Make it informative but catchy and remember to include key terms.	Research how long Henry VIII was married to each wife. Using this information, what fraction of his married life did Henry spend with each of his wives? Express the fractions in their lowest term.	Sew, print, make or design something a Tudor (rich or poor) would wear.
	Create a newspaper front page report following the split with the Catholic Church. Make sure you include details of why the split took place.	Create a pie chart to represent the data of how long Henry Tudor, Henry VIII, Edward VI, Mary and Elizabeth reigned for.	Design a Tudor board game. You can research actual games played by the Tudors or create your own versions. Include board, instructions, rules, counters etc.

Challenge: Create and complete your own task related to your class topic.

You can present your work any way you want to; on the computer, drawings, models etc. Express your ideas!
