Homework Arrangements

Nursery

Year 2 will receive SATs packs during the late Spring term/early Summer term

Year 6 will receive SATs revision packs from the Spring term.

From Year 1 — 6, homework will be given out at the start of the half term, in the form of a Learning Log, allowing sufficient time to be completed. This will also be uploaded to the website. A 'Home Learning Log' will contain 9 tasks: 3 English, 3 Maths and 3 topic/science. They will be rated from 1 star to 3 stars, with 1 star being the easiest level to 3 stars being the hardest. Children can choose a minimum of <u>at least</u> one English task, one maths task and one topic/science task.

Reading records are checked daily.

Spelling tests for Years 1 – 6 will take place on a MONDAY.

All pupils are expected to complete homework on time. Teachers will keep records of pupils completing homework which will be regularly checked. If pupils fail to complete homework, teachers, Deputy Headteacher or Headteacher will contact parents to find out why. The Deputy Headteacher will monitor KS2 reading and spellings on a weekly basis. In KS1, children will complete their homework in school during playtime if it has not been returned on time. In KS2, children will practise their spelling in school or read on a Monday lunchtime if these have not been done at home.

Children will be rewarded at the end of a term for completing homework on time.
