Choose at least one English task, one maths task and one topic/science task from the table below. The tasks are ranked accordingly, from 1 star being the easiest level to 3 stars being the hardest. You can choose which level you complete. If you wish to, you could complete more than three tasks.

Star Ranking:	ENGLISH	MATHS	TOPIC/SCIENCE
	Write your own description of a 'rare' animal. It could be imaginary, an extinct animal or an animal with a unique appearance e.g. A blue elephant. Remember to use ambitious words and vocabulary including expanded noun phrases.	Find out the population of the different species of fox in the UK. Present your findings in either a table, bar chart or pie chart.	Show on a map of the UK where different fox species live and their population. Remember to include a key!
	Write your own diary entry from any character's point of view. Remember to describe your thoughts and feelings when first encountering the fox.	Create a recipe card for Aunt Millie together with measurements for the ingredients and diagrams to show the instructions. Think about how many people it would serve?	Plan and undertake an experiment to separate a range of different materials. Consider different methods e.g. evaporation, filtering, magnets etc. Record your findings.
	Write an interview between a news reporter and a chosen character from the story.	Imagine you have been given £5000 to spend on a fox sanctuary. List how you would spend this money. Think about the amenities a fox would need and research how much these would cost. Work out your costings and show your working out.	Create a model of Aunt Millie and Uncle Fred's farm inferring what you think it looks like from details specified in the text.
