Choose <u>at least</u> one English task, one maths task and one creative task from the table below. The tasks are ranked accordingly, from 1 star being the easiest level to 3 stars being the hardest. You can choose which level you complete. If you wish to, you could complete <u>more than</u> three tasks.

	Find definitions for: banquet, monasteries, protestant, reformation, supremacy, treason and Poor Law. Present these words in a glossary. Think carefully about how you will present it.	Create a bar chart to represent the data of how long Henry Tudor, Henry VIII, Edward VI, Mary and Elizabeth reigned for.	Create a menu for either: a) A feast at the Royal Palace, or b) A day in a normal person's house. Cook, bake, draw, or use pictures to make a collage of your meals on the menu.
	Find out all that you can about Edward VI. Present your findings in a double page spread format.	Using Tudor key words and information, create 5 word problems to show the four operations; addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Could some word problems show more than one operation?	Sew, print, make or design something a Tudor (rich or poor) would wear.
***	Create a newspaper report which would be worthy of a front page about the split with the Catholic Church. Include the details of why Henry VIII wanted this to happen.	Research how long Henry VIII was married to each wife. Using this information, what fraction of his married life did Henry spend with each of his wives? Express the fractions in their lowest term.	Design a Tudor board game. You can research actual games played by the Tudors or create your own versions. Include a board, instructions, rules, counters etc.

Challenge: Create and complete your own task related to your class topic.

You can present your work any way you want to; on the computer, drawings, models etc. Express your ideas!
