




English:

We will be continuing with our Read Write Inc phonics programme at individual levels.




In reading, we will continue to develop the skill of reading for understanding, to read expressively, to make predictions about what might happen in the story and to look at the features of information texts.

Within classes we will be looking at stories focussing on characters and settings, information texts and poetry. The children will write in sentences using finger spaces between each word, a capital letter to begin each sentence and a full stop at the end. We will look at improving our writing by including more detail and writing at greater length.

Maths:

In maths we will be:

- Understanding the place value of 2 and 3 digit numbers.
- Counting in tens and finding 10 more and less than a number.
- Learning number bonds to 10 and 20.
- Learning the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.
- The value of coins to one pound and finding total amounts.
- Weighing objects and measuring length and capacity.
- Telling the time to the hour and half past.
- Adding and subtracting numbers.



Creative Curriculum:

Our Topic is "Dinosaur Planet".

We will be learning about dinosaurs and we will be imagining that we are palaeontologists (A scientists who studies bones and fossils). We are going to dig deep and discover dazzling dinosaur facts. We will be doing dinosaur dances and producing some prehistoric percussion! Which is your favourite dinosaur?

History

We will be learning about dinosaurs, learning about events beyond living memory and we will be investigating what happened to the dinosaurs.

Art/DT

We will be working as a team to create models of dinosaurs using junk materials, individually using clay and baking dinosaur biscuits.

Music

We will be creating sound effects using the voice, body percussion, everyday objects and percussion instruments.

RE and PSHE

In R.E, we will be considering God from a Christian point of view and looking at beliefs. We will also look at the celebration of Easter.

In PSHE, the children will be thinking about themselves; what makes them proud and their gifts and talents. They will also be setting goals to achieve within school.

British Values:

We will be looking at differences between right and wrong and the rules within society. We will be encouraging the children to explain their own views and listen to others.

Computing:

We will be programming robots using an algorithm and using a search engine.



PE:

In gymnastics we will be identifying and using basic gymnastic shapes and actions. In dance we will build simple movement patterns.
